WHY IS MY SCHOOL IDENTIFIED FOR IMPROVEMENT?

- Our school has not made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) for the last two years¹, based on state ISTEP+ test results.

AS A PARENT, WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS UNDER SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT?

SCHOOL CHOICE

- All students may transfer to a different school in our district.
- You are not required to move your student to a new school.
- The school district will provide one option for you.
- The school district will pay for all transportation costs as long as the school continues to be in improvement.
- If our school comes out of improvement (after making AYP for two consecutive years), your child may stay at the transfer school, but you will have to provide transportation.

FREE TUTORING
