Parent Orientation Information

School Mission: Our mission is to equip students to achieve their potential and positively impact their community.

School Creed: Be Respectful, Be Responsible, Be Ready.

Staff to Student Ratio:

- Current enrollment is 727
- Current Class Size: 26-29 students

Lockers: Each student will have his/her own locker.

Lunch:

- Students select their own seats.
- Students have a minimum of 20 minutes to eat their lunch & are dismissed by class.

Recess:

- Fourth Grade has a morning recess and a lunch recess
- Fifth Grade has one recess (lunch recess)
- Options: Zone 1 (playground), Zone 2 (blacktop), Reading Room/Game Room

Teacher Teams:

- Fourth Grade: 5 teams of 2; 1 team of 3
 - Teams of Two: one teacher teaches math, the other teacher teaches reading.
 - Students have a homeroom teacher/class. They switch one time during the day for either reading or math.
 - Team of Three:
 - One teacher teaches math, one teaches reading, one teaches alternating units of science and social studies
 - Students have a homeroom teacher/class. They rotate twice per day.
 - Team classrooms are next door, or one door down at most
- Fifth Grade: 2 teams of 2; 3 teams of 3

School Hours:

- M, T, Th, F: 8:00-2:25 (students may enter the building starting at 7:40.)
- Wednesday: 8:25-2:25 (students may enter the building starting at 8:05.)

Transportation:

- All MCS students are only allowed one pick up location and one drop off location. Please be sure to notify Transportation of any changes in your address or childcare arrangements, including Boys & Girls Club participation.
- In the morning, HIS students ride the bus to their former elementary school with K-3 students, and then they get on an “Express Bus” to come to Heritage. Once the Express Buses depart the elementary schools, they do NOT stop to pick students up along the way.
- In the afternoon, we run our own routes, so only Intermediate School students are on the bus at this time. We do bus students to the Boys and Girls Club (students are NOT permitted to walk).
- Bus drop-off and pick-up occurs in the front of our building, along the north side of Northridge Middle School.
- Car Riders:
 - Student drop-off (A.M.) takes place at the front of our building (7:40-8:00).
 - We have two locations to drop off. Traditional drop-off is directly in front of the main entrance. For parents who arrive early and wish to sit and wait, please use this drop-off route.
 - “Express Drop Off” enters at the back of the building by the tennis courts and winds around to the front of the building. This is a drop-and-go location with no pulling over to the side to wait to drop.
 - Student pick-up (P.M.) takes place in the same location as the a.m. “Express Drop Off” at door 2. Enter by the tennis courts, wind around to the front of the building. Students being picked up must have a Red Card to give to an adult prior to getting in their car.
 - Maps will be provided in back-to-school packets.

First Day of School: Wednesday, August 15, 2018. We promise to take good care of your child(ren). On the first day, we gather ALL of the students in the main gym with their teacher. We will introduce them to key people (nurse, counselor, etc...) and will share some general information. We will then dismiss them from the gym by classroom so that EVERY student will know where to go. They will follow their classroom teacher to their new classroom and then the day will continue from that point with procedures and questions. Fourth grade teachers will also take their students on a building tour. They will NOT change classrooms on the first day of school.
